STUDENT RIGHT TO KNOW

Approximately 2,011 first time in college, full-time enrolled, credential seeking students entered PCC in fall 2018. By the end of three years, 18% of the students graduated from PCC and an additional 17% transferred to another post-secondary institution before completing a PCC credential.
